Tax Reminder Notices have been sent in the mail. If you still need to pay your taxes please know the municipality can be set up as a payee at your banking institution to pay tax bills online, by telephone or in person at the bank. Your account number is your roll number omitting the "4944" and the last 4 zeros. If you have more than one property please make sure you clearly indicate what roll number the funds are applied to. For online banking, each property needs to be added as an account and paid accordingly.

Recreation

On the first and third Wednesday of each month at 10AM, head over to the Magnetawan Community Centre and join in playing Pickle Ball: a sport blending physical, mental and social elements together, since it works both your legs and upper body. Pickle ball is a paddle sport that combines elements of badminton, tennis, and table tennis. 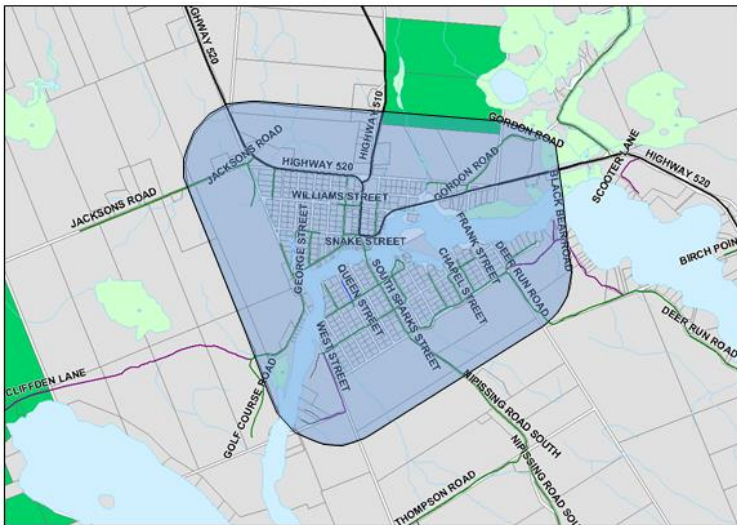

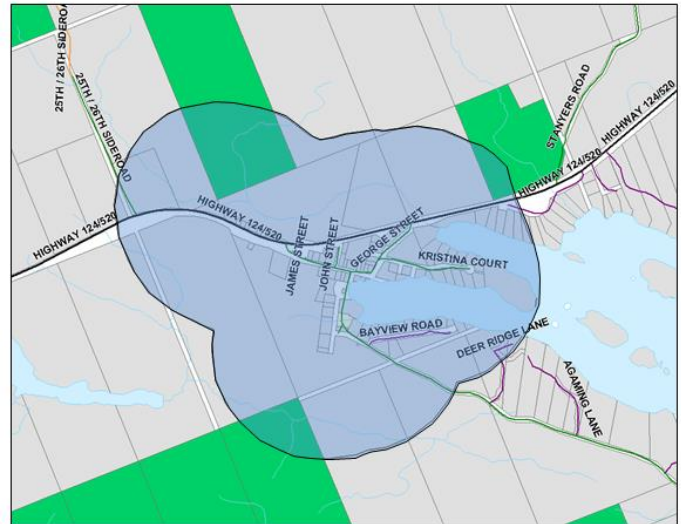

BY-LAW – Feeding of Wildlife By-Law

On August 22, 2018, Magnetawan Council adopted By-law 2018-59 to prohibit the feeding of wildlife in the urban areas. This By-law addresses concerns with the feeding of deer, seagulls, geese, and other wildlife in Magnetawan and Ahmic Harbour, which often poses significant risks to the health, safety, and quality of life of our human and animal residents and visitors alike.
