Items Brought Forward

2.1 Event for Easter - Magnetawan Central Public School

The Committee discussed the success of the Easter Baskets that were distributed to all the students at the Magnetawan Central Public School. The students and staff were very thankful, and the Facebook post had many positive responses from the community, with some parents posting pictures of their happy children.

2.2 Verbal Update Digital Photo Frame Heritage Center – Brand of Equipment and Inventory of Pictures

The Secretary advised the Committee that the equipment has been delivered. Any extra historical pictures have been located at the Heritage Museum. The Chair has picked up all the equipment and some of the historical pictures to start digitizing. The Library has also lent CDs with historical pictures and the Chair is currently working on digitizing these as well. Committee member Marilyn Raaflaub has located some historical pictures at her home and will be dropping them off to the office as they should be in the possession of the Museum. The Secretary will let the Chair know when they are dropped off. It was discussed that any pictures that are not historical, or have not been submitted but found, and/or have less than three children in the picture should not be considered.

The Secretary advised that two specially ordered cabinets will be installed at the Heritage Museum one behind the desk to offer a secure place to keep the Digital Photo Frame as the cabinet locks and one to be used as a display case for artifacts.



Annex: Guide for Virtual Events

Meet the Program Objectives

- Ensure that the event meets the objectives of the Program.
- Remember that Canada Day celebrations must take place on July 1, and that other celebrations must take place during the period of June 21 to July 1, 2021.

What is Your Vision?

- Choose a date and time for your event.
- Decide on a platform (your organization's website, YouTube, Instagram, Snapchat, Facebook Live, Twitter Live, Vimeo, Zoom, Teams Live Event, Grenadine, etc.).
- Determine the scope of the project (local, regional, pan-Canadian).
- Determine the type of virtual event you want to have (hybrid, live, semi-live, pre-recorded).
- Form partnerships with other organizations that can help with facilitation, equipment, production and distribution.
- Promote your event in advance so your audience knows how and when to tune in (and don't forget to use #hashtags to widen your reach!)
- Ensure cultural and linguistic representation as you plan: showcase both official languages, and represent the diversity of your community in the content of your event (youth, seniors, multicultural groups, Indigenous people).

On behalf of the Department of Canadian Heritage's Celebrate Canada Program, I am writing to you to share the options available for your 2021 event.

VIRTUAL OPTION

The Program strongly encourages all clients holding an in-person event to prepare a virtual option. Due to the constant changes of public health COVID-19 protocols, you may not be able to hold your event as originally planned, and therefore it is important to develop a back-up plan that can be easily executed if you are not able to hold your in-person event.

If you do decide to hold a virtual event instead of an in-person event, please advise us as soon as possible in order for us to accurately list your event on our website.

POSTPONE

Due to the ongoing nature of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Celebrate Canada Program will allow clients to postpone their planned events until **September 6, 2021**, provided the event is the same as described in your funding application.

We ask that you advise us of your new event date as soon as possible in order for us to accurately list your event on our website.

CANCEL

If you have decided to cancel your event this year, please advise us by e-mail as soon as possible so in order for us to accurately list your event on our website. Your departmental representative can give you information on how to return your funds.

If you wish to cancel your activities, but have incurred expenses related to the event since April 2021, you may be eligible for a reimbursement. Please send us an e-mail advising us of your decision and outlining the expenses incurred. Your departmental representative will assess your request and determine the amount of eligible expenses.

Of note, in light of the public health COVID-19 protocols, no promotional items will be sent out for the 2021 Celebrate Canada Period (Canada Day, National Indigenous Peoples Day, Saint-Jean Baptiste Day, and Canadian Multiculturalism Day). The Department of Canadian Heritage is currently working on virtual alternatives that will be offered to Celebrate Canada clients in the future.


