COVID-19 Vaccine Clinics This Week, By Appointment or Walk-in

NIPISSING & PARRY SOUND, ON – Walk-ins aged five and older are welcome at COVID-19 vaccine clinics taking place this week. First, second, third and fourth doses will be offered to eligible individuals. Face coverings are required at all clinics. Individuals should bring a health card or another form of identification, if possible.

The following clinics are taking place this week:

North Bay

- Wednesday, June 29 at Elks Lodge (325 Elks Ln., North Bay) from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m.

Parry Sound

- Thursday, June 30 at North Bay Parry Sound District Health Unit (70 Joseph St., Parry Sound) from noon to 4 p.m.

Sundridge

- Wednesday, June 29 at SSJ Arena (14 Albert St. N, Sundridge) from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m.
