COVID-19 Vaccine Clinics This Week

NIPISSING & PARRY SOUND, ON – COVID-19 vaccine clinics will take place in Nipissing and Parry Sound this week, with the flu shot offered to a limited number of walk-ins.

Individuals may walk in for a flu shot with or without also receiving the COVID-19 vaccine. It is safe to receive the flu shot at any point after receiving a COVID-19 vaccine, and vice versa.

COVID-19 vaccine clinics this week include:

North Bay

- Tuesday, Feb. 7 at Elks Lodge (325 Elks Ln., North Bay) from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m.

Parry Sound

- Thursday, Feb. 9 at Parry Sound Mall (70 Joseph St., Parry Sound) from 2:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Individuals are reminded to wear a face covering at clinics and, if possible, bring a health card or another form of identification. Booked appointments are preferred, as availability for walk-in appointments will be limited.

The bivalent COVID-19 vaccine will be offered as a booster dose to individuals aged five and older if a minimum of three months (84 days) have passed since their last dose or COVID-19 infection. It is particularly important that [Individuals who are at higher risk of severe illness from COVID-19](#), including all individuals aged 65 and older, receive a booster dose as soon as they are eligible. At this time, no extra booster doses are recommended if one has been received since September 1, 2022.
