Ensure your property has working smoke and carbon monoxide alarms. Change the batteries every six (6) months.



Install a residential sprinkler system



Ensure you have fire extinguishers on hand. Check fire extinguishers frequently!

Call 911 and **EVACUATE** immediately!
Plan a way out – by boat or other!

If your emergency evacuation plan includes a boat – hide an extra set of boat keys outside your home. Keep your boat gassed and at the ready.

Install a lake pump with a hose.

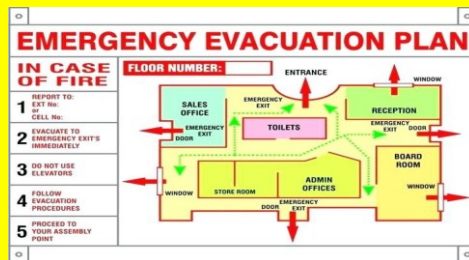
Have frequent guests? Ensure that guests are aware of evacuation plans and follow the fire rules!



Burn in accordance with the Municipality's Open Air Burning By-law and always check with your local department if you are not sure!



Practice your emergency evacuation plan



Keep an emergency preparedness kit that includes a fully stocked first aid kit
